I. Introduction

The Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) of National Taipei University of Education will organize and hold the Mandarin Summer Camp in 2013. The program will give the youth and children the opportunity to learn Mandarin and experience the Taiwanese culture through all kinds of teaching activities during the camp.

II. Course plan

1. Applicant : Individuals or groups, ranging from the ages of 6-15. Students will be divided according to their Mandarin proficiency; no experience is also acceptable.
2. Location : National Taipei University of Education. 106, No.134, Sec. 2, Heping East Rd., Taipei (located near MRT Technology Building Station)
3. Class Size : Each class will have a minimum of eight (8) students and a maximum of twelve (12) students.
4. Duration :
 - Session I: 2013/06/24 (Monday) to 2013/07/19 (Friday)
 - Session II: 2013/07/22 (Monday) to 2013/08/16 (Friday)
5. Class Hours : Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 16:00
6. Application Deadline : Until all sessions are full.
7. All times in this document are based on Taiwan's time.

IV. Price of each session

1. Price per session: US\$1,350 (Tuition: US\$1,315 + Processing Fee: US\$35)
2. Price per session: NT\$38,500 (Tuition: NT\$37,500 + Processing Fee: NT\$ 1,000)
3. The price of each session includes tuition, books, materials expense, lunch, dessert, transportation costs, entrance fees, meal expenses during field trips, and insurance. During the summer camp, each participant will be insured NT\$1,000,000 of accident insurance and NT\$100,000 of accidental medical insurance.

Please note that, once paid, the processing fee cannot be refunded.

Each student is limited to only one discount option.

Option I : Early Bird Special

- From now until 31 December 2012: US\$1,215 (NT\$34,750)
- 1 January 2013 to 28 February 2013: US\$1,280 (NT\$36,500)

Option II : Returning Student: US\$1,087 (NT\$31,000)

Option III : Group Discount (must enroll at the same time & price reflected is per student)

- Two (2) students: 5% discount – US\$1,284.25 (NT\$36,625)
- Three (3) students: 10% discount – US\$1,218.50 (NT\$34,750)
- Four (4) students: 15% discount – US\$1,152.75 (NT\$32,875)
- Five (5) students or more: 20% discount – US\$1,087 (NT\$31,000)
